

RESOLUTION OF THE

WHEREAS, the Town Board is considering a change from the current system of three elected Assessors to a single appointed Assessor, pursuant to Section 328 of the New York Real Property Tax Law;

WHEREAS, the attached proposed Local Law No. 1 of 2019 would effectuate such a change;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the duly convened Town Board of the Town of Rensselaerville that pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law and the General Municipal Law, a Public Hearing shall be conducted at the Town Hall on July 9, 2019 at 6:30 pm on the attached proposed Local Law No. 1 of 2019, and notice of the time and place of such hearing shall be published on or before July 3, 2019 in a newspaper circulating in the Town.

By motion made by Supervisor John Dolce and seconded by Councilwoman Margaret Sedlmeir, the foregoing resolution was adopted by a majority of the members of the Town Board of the Town of Rensselaerville on the 13th day of June 2019 as follows:

End Resolution

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW No. 1 of 2019
TOWN OF RENSSELAERVILLE, NEW YORK

A local law to establish a single Assessor for the Town.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Rensselaerville, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Repeal and Amend: Local Law No. 1 of 1971 of the Town Law of the Town of Rensselaerville, codified as Chapter Five of the Town Law of the Town of Rensselaerville, is hereby repealed and the following is adopted in its place.

Section 2. Single Assessor: Pursuant to New York Real Property Tax Law Section 328, there shall be a single appointed Assessor for the Town of Rensselaerville, appointed by the Town Board pursuant to the applicable provisions of the New York Real Property Tax Law.

Section 3. Term: The term of office for the initial appointed Assessor shall commence on January 1, 2020 and shall terminate on September 30, 2025. Thereafter, the term of office for the appointed Assessor shall be six years, commencing October 1 and terminating on September 30, as set for the in Section 328 of the New York Real Property Tax Law.

Section 4. Current Assessors: The terms of office of the Town's current three elected Assessors shall terminate on December 31, 2019.

Section 5. Effective Date: This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
