Water Emergency Now in Effect

Dear Neighbors:

Yesterday we informed you of the potential for a water emergency in the district. We have followed all leads and made every effort to locate the source of the water losses we are currently experiencing but have had little success. We now need to declare a water emergency.

We have reached out for technical assistance from companies that have assisted us in the past with leak detection. We are in the process of sourcing Potable water from the New York State Department of Emergency Management Services and from vendors of potable water approved by the Albany County Department of Health, in order to augment the amount that we filter on a daily basis.

What we are asking of you is that you conserve water to the greatest degree possible

Please check all fixtures to make sure that none are unintentionally left on or damaged. Last summer the water loses the District experienced were the result of leaking plumbing fixtures. PLEASE examine all indoor and outdoor fixtures and secure or repair any damaged, leaking, or unattended open devices.

We will keep the community informed of events as they unfold. If any interruption of water service is anticipated, we will notify District residents as soon as possible. We do not expect service interruptions, but we cannot rule out the possibility that one may occur. In the event of such a development, you would receive information from the Albany County Department of Health regarding procedures to follow.
